8th IPA Assembly



The Trustees of the IPA decided to create a new organisational structure for the Association that will facilitate a more sustainable organisation for the future and will put structure on a more collaborative system between Presentation Sisters and their Partners in Justice work.

Assembly Outcomes

1. To operationalise the Trustees' Decision to create a new governance structure for IPA
 - Determine the Members of IPA (International Presentation Association Members).
 - Appoint a new board and chairperson.
 - Sanction the appointment of a new Executive Director.
2. To institute the role and staff changes that this new structure may require.
3. To offer training and supports to effect these changes and all new clarifications of role.
4. To create a new strategy 2024-2026 which reviews and amends the 2020-2022 Education and Action for Justice Strategy in ways that reflect the spirit, discussions and deliberations of the 8th Assembly.
5. To continue our commitment to honouring the **dignity of all**.
6. To develop further the possibilities and the impact of the interconnection between the grassroots justice Work and the IPA advocacy work at the UN; to research the impact of the IPA advocacy work at the UN.
7. To professionalise the Communications at all levels in IPA, internally, intra-Trustees and externally.
8. With renewed respect for the cultural diversity of IPA and the people with whom it works and for whom it advocates, IPA to pay acute attention to its use of language, and do all it can to ensure that its structures, events, communications and ways of working are inclusive.
